- The aim is to **introduce practical examples** and **facilitate a discussion** on approaches to international cooperation and related benefits.

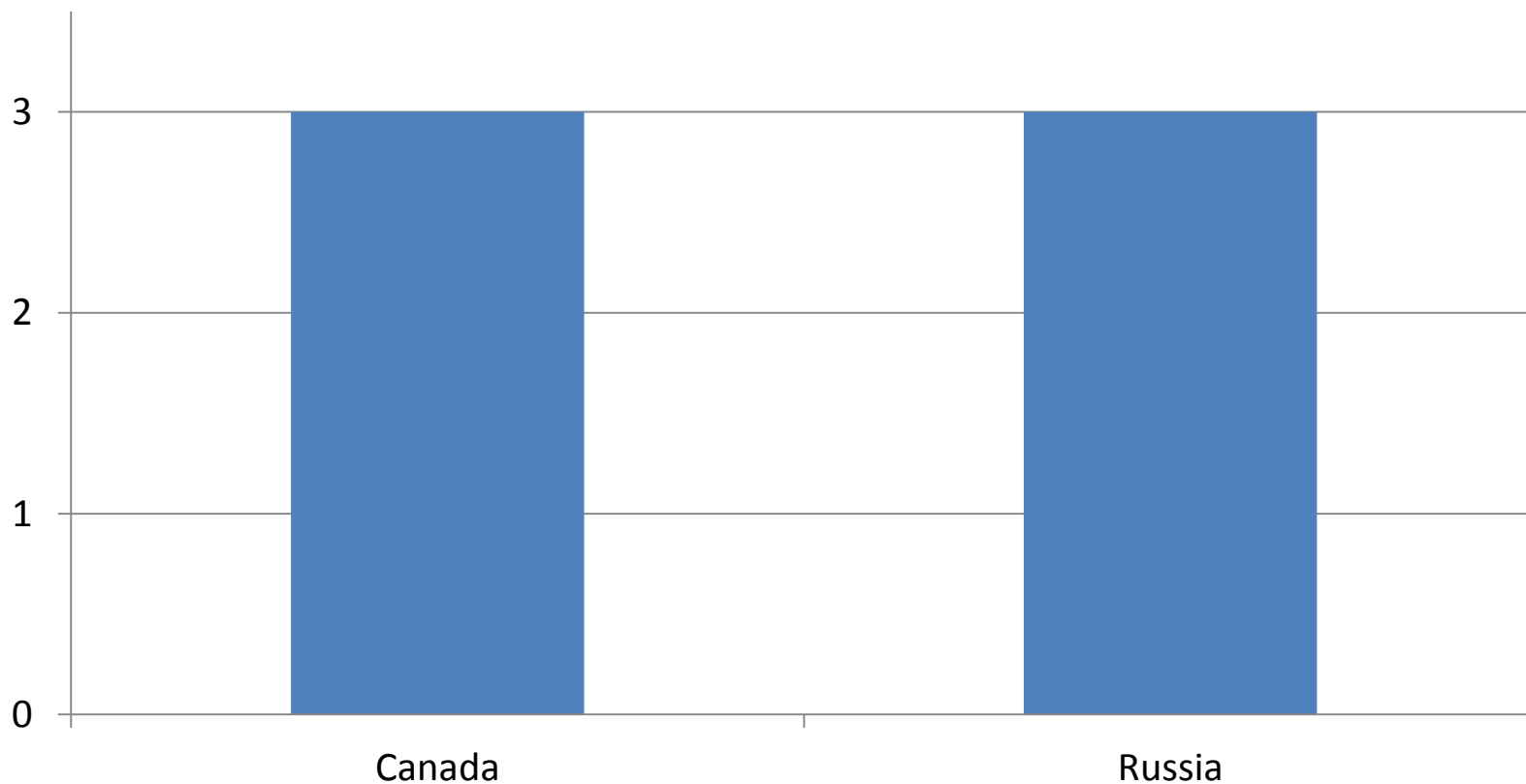

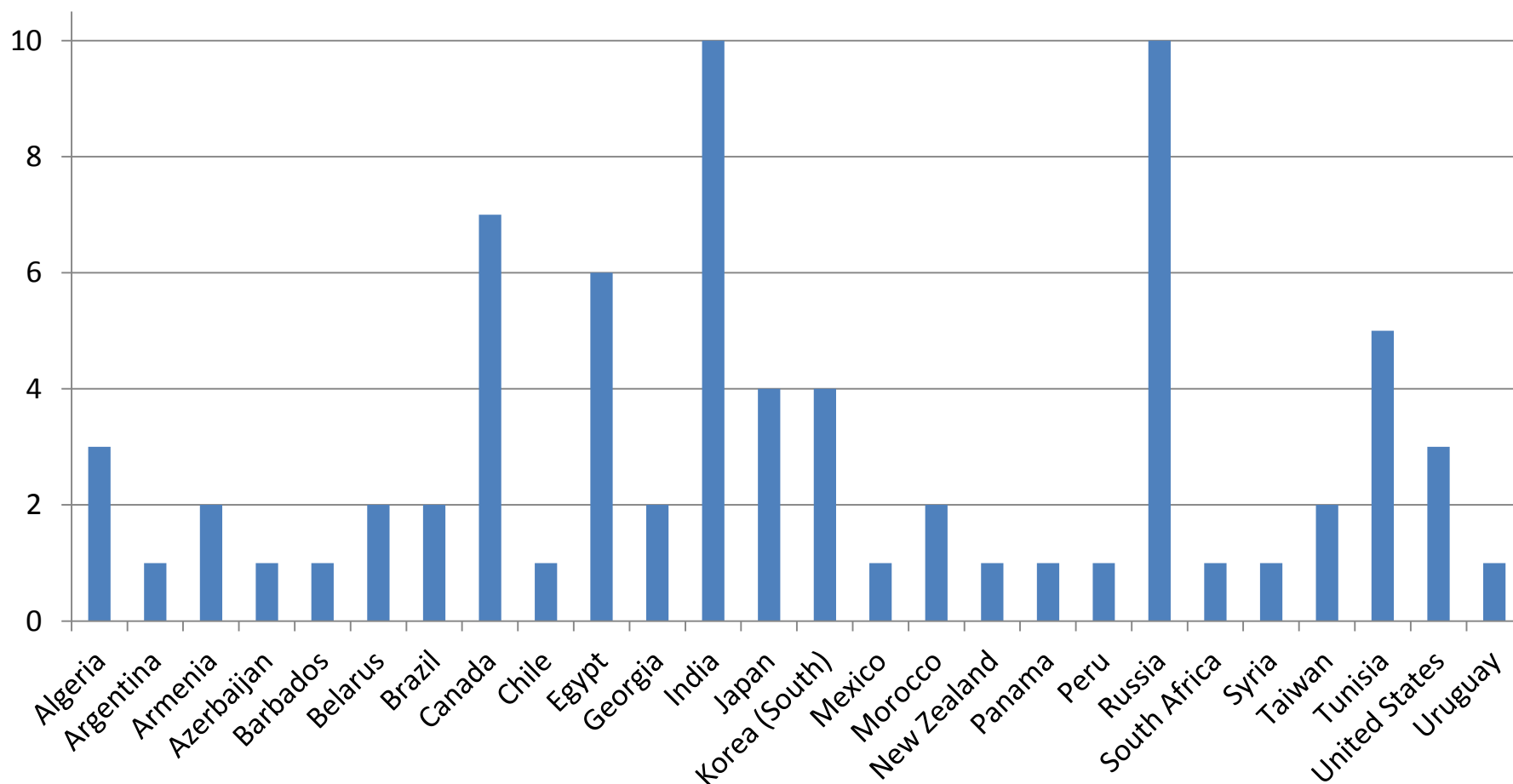
International participations in FP6 P2Ps

International participations in FP7 P2Ps

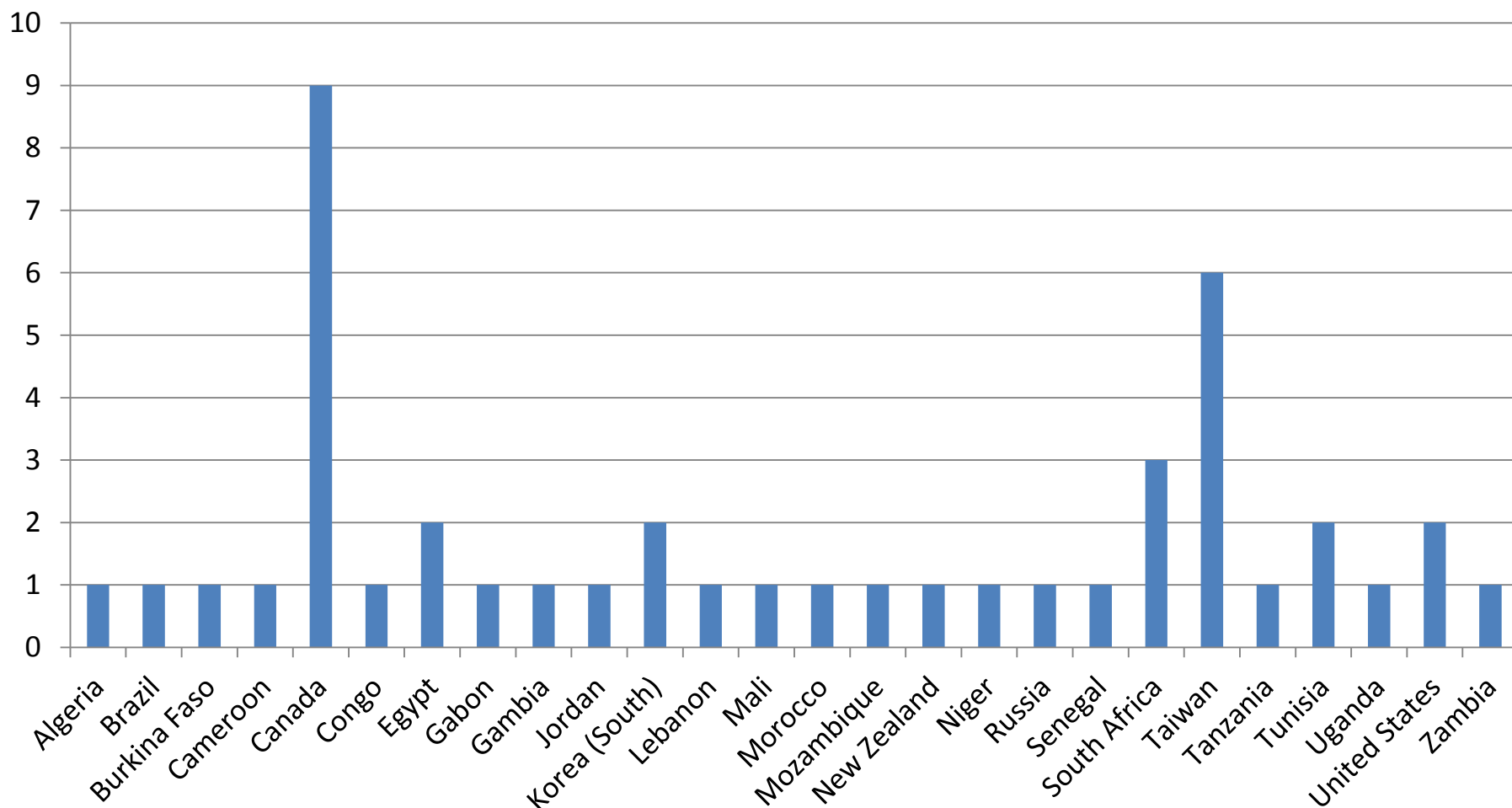




Statistics: P2P in H2020

26 international partner countries; 45 participations

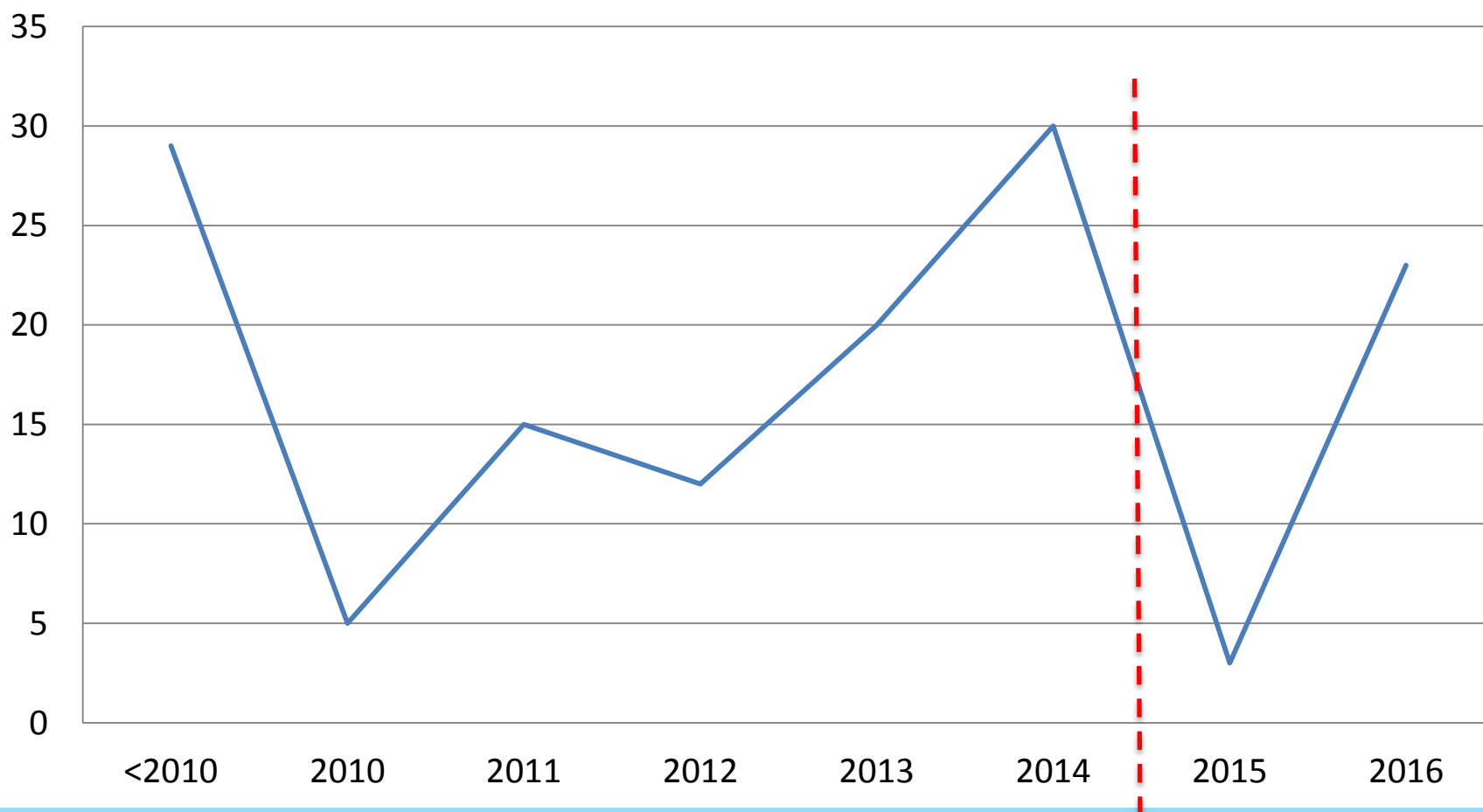
International participations in H2020 P2Ps (2014-2016)



Statistics: starting dates of P2P with international participation

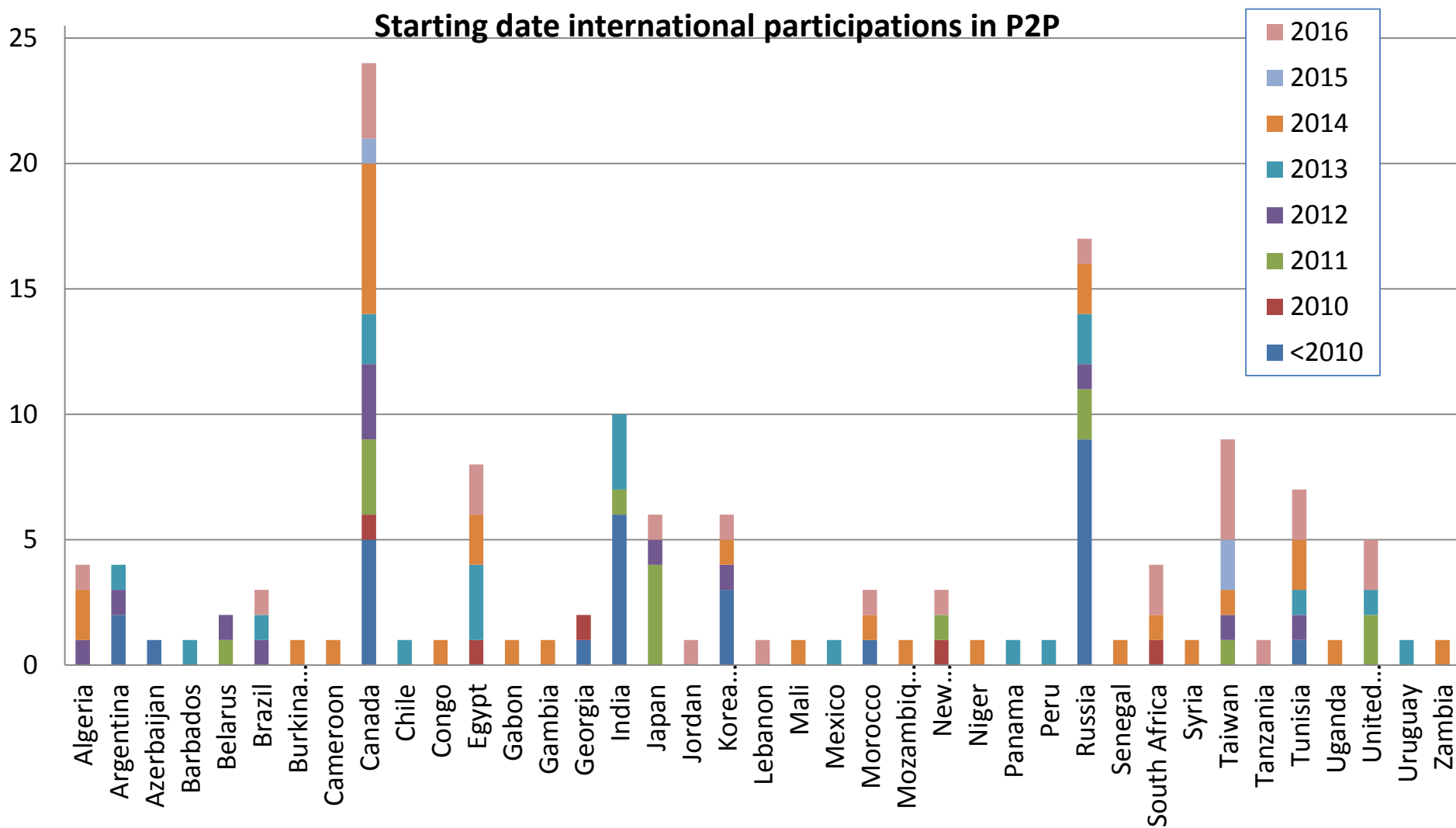
137 international participations in 54 P2Ps

Starting date international participations in P2P

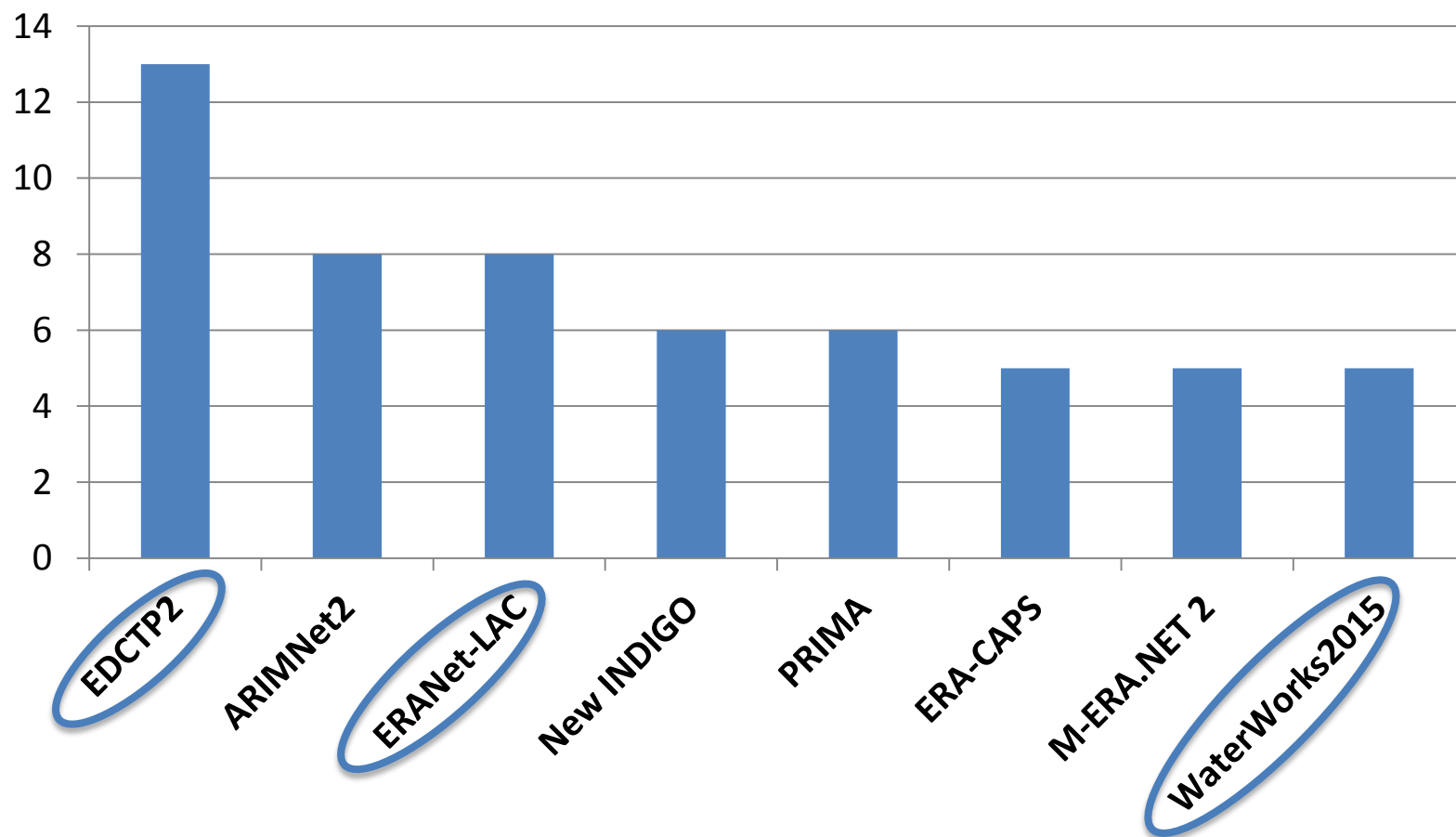


Statistics: starting dates of P2P with international participation
