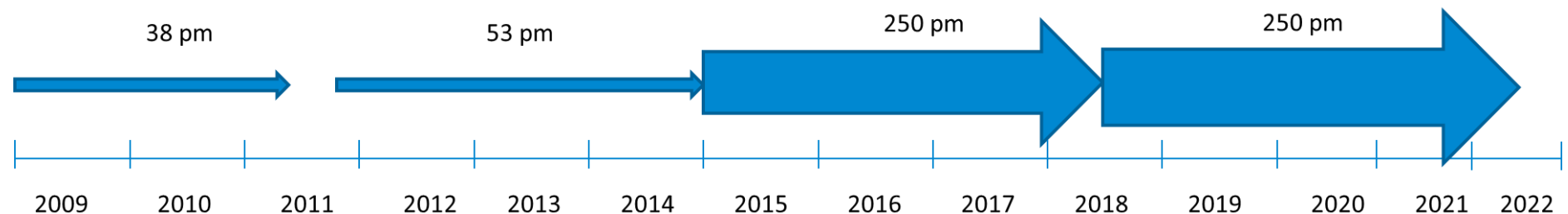

# ERA-LEARN: 10 years of support for Partnerships

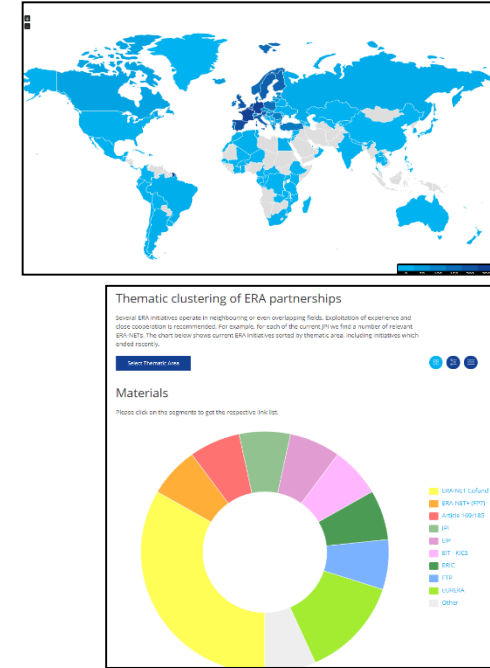
- consortium of funding organisations and analysts

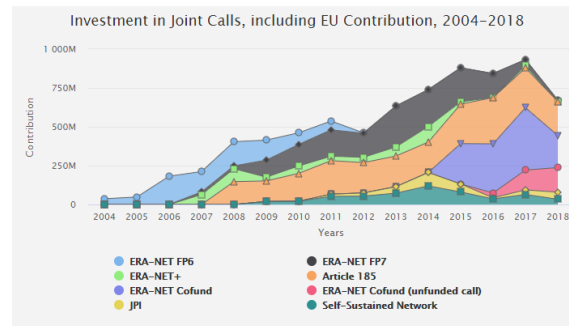
## ERA-LEARN: service provider

- databases:
  - networks, countries, organisations
  - joint calls, funded projects
  - thematic information
- good practice examples: activities beyond joint calls
- guidance material & toolkits
  - support impact assessments –RIPE toolkit
  - identify and spread good practise for specific common challenges (e.g. widening and inclusiveness, internationalisation)

Next to the implementation of joint calls, a variety of joint activities are carried out by the different P2P-consortia. ERA-LEARN introduces categories of these activities and illustrates these with examples from different P2P-networks.

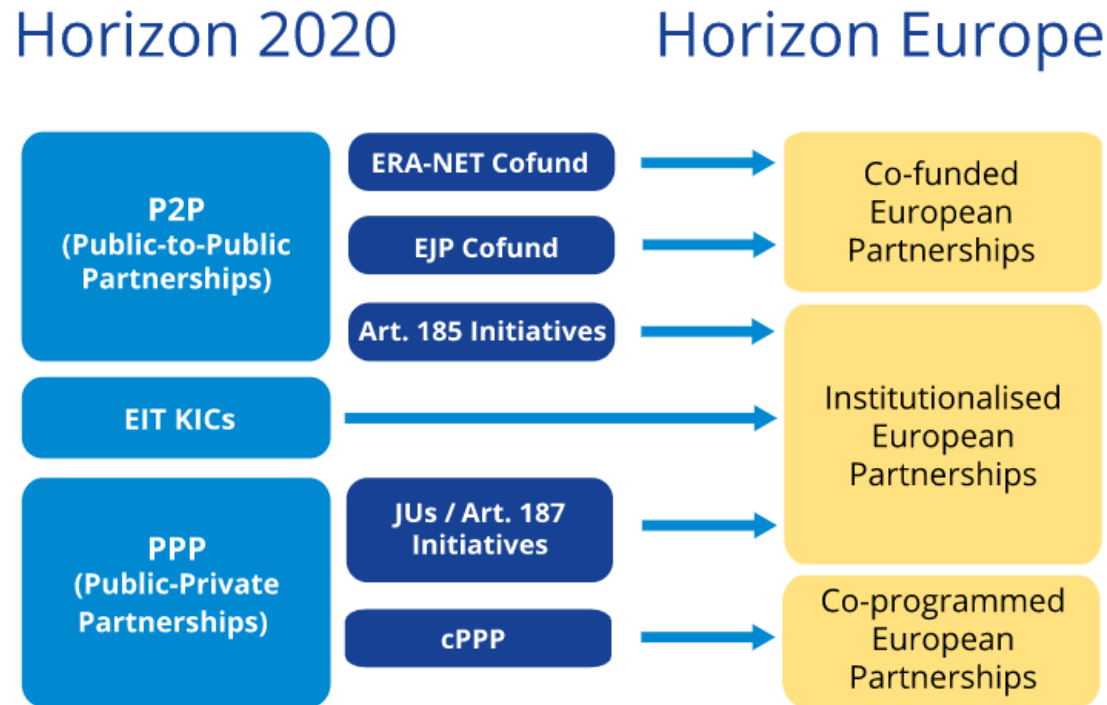


# ERA-LEARN: main goals 2018-2022
