BONUS status

- **5 calls in BONUS Art 185 and 1 in BONUS+**
- Currently open – synthesis call, 18-month desk-top studies start in 2018
- **56 projects worth ca. EUR 120 million** involving a total of 16 countries – **27 projects still ongoing**
- Over 100 region's leading universities and institutions and 35 businesses
- **More than 1000 researchers**
- Coordinating and delivering cutting edge science technological advances
- Final evaluation published in October 2017
