## Messages

- **Mutual learning** of stakeholders / researchers / policy makers > overcoming prejudices
- Move from **consulting to partnership**, from **advice to solutions**
- **Different ways of involving** different stakeholders
  - Move beyond advisory boards!
  - Local, national, EU level
  - 4<sup>th</sup> hybrid sector
- Stakeholder engagement based on **structured and strategic process**; analysis and impact; needs to be planned carefully; societal interaction plan



## Messages

- Researchers, don't be afraid: there's **no trade off between academic excellence and societal engagement**
- Lots of tools and instruments are already available, **resources and experts are needed**
