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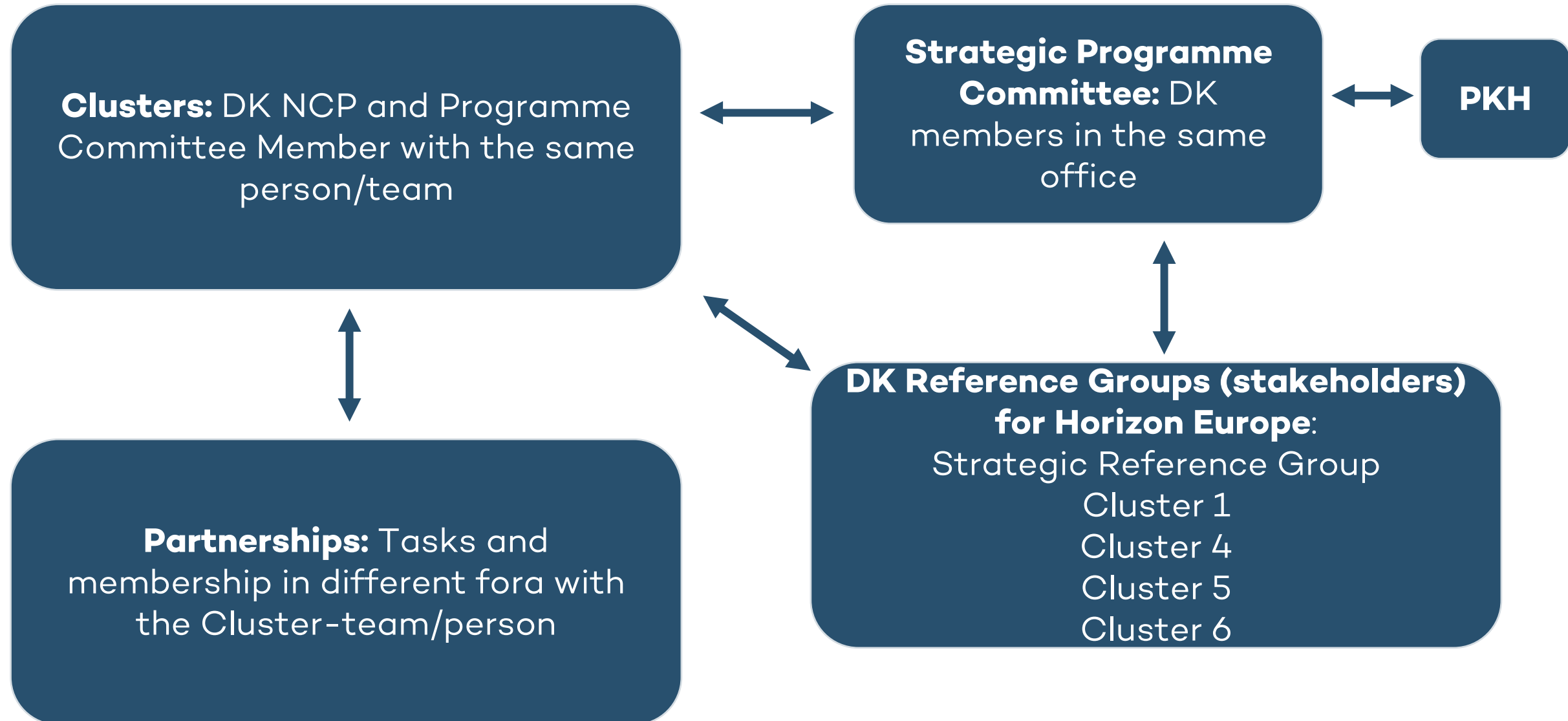

Advantages

- **Coordination is 'easy' = 'everything' in one office**

- **Many tasks to juggle for one person**
