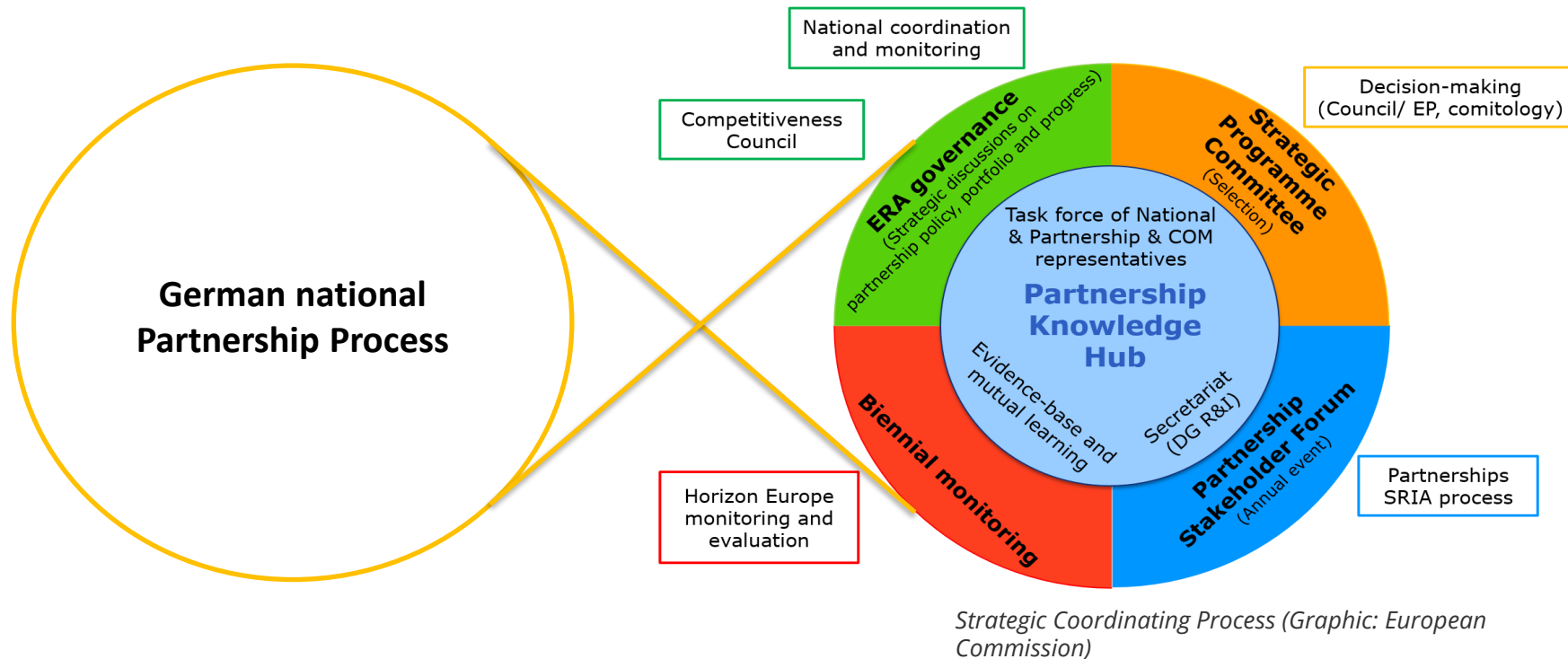

Contact Point European Partnerships

Central point for information and exchange

- Ensures **mutual learning**, raises awareness concerning the **needs of stakeholders**, provides **guidance**
- **Supports national actors on matters of implementation** (e.g. legal requirements, reporting, commitments etc.)
