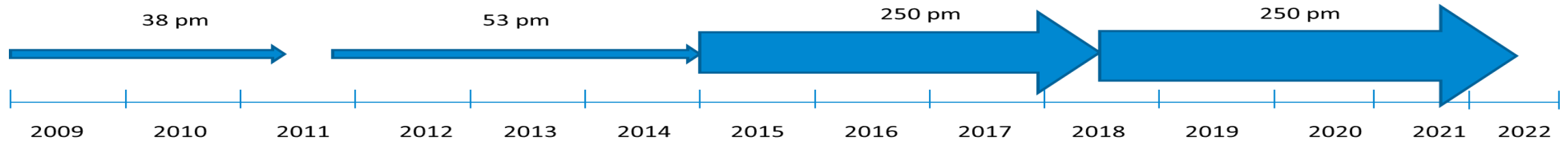

1 July 2018 – 30 June 2022

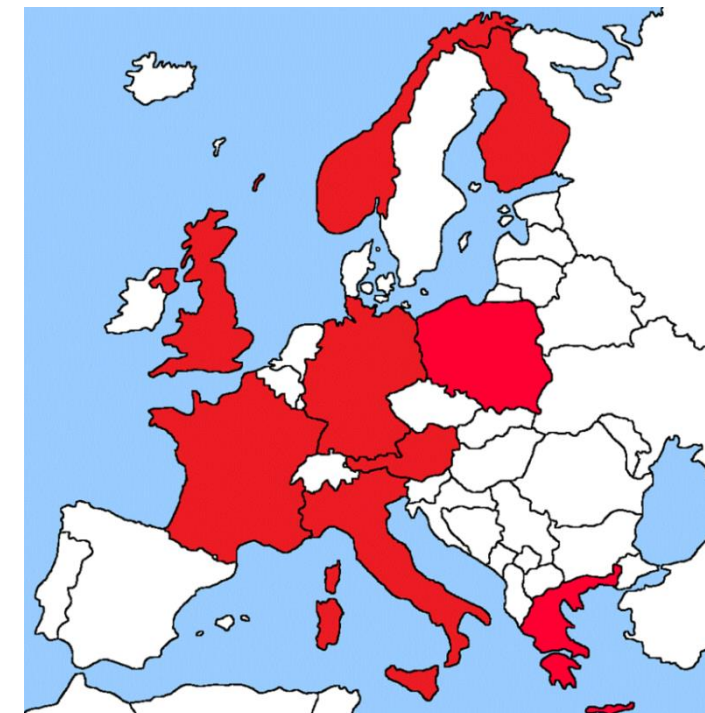



In June 2018 the Commission adopted its proposal for Horizon Europe, the 9th EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation, which will become operational from January 2021 onwards. While the proposal's overall policy is 'evolution and no revolution', the part on 'European Partnerships' differs significantly from Horizon 2020.

- **aim of the workshop: to bring wide range of different partnerships together**
- **73 networks represented, all types of partnerships well covered**
 - Art. 187: 7 (out of 8)
 - Art. 185: 5 (out of 6)
 - EIT-KIC: 4 (out of 8)
 - cPPP: 4 (out of 9)
 - FET flagships: 2 (out of 3)
 - EJP: 4 (out of 6)
 - JPI: 8 (out of 10)
 - EJP: 4 (out of 6)
 - ERA-NET COFUND: 41 (out of 62)

Content to discuss:

- ERA-LEARN "discussion papers" on thematic partnerships

Goals:

- discuss main observations from the thematic analyses & receive expert feedback from existing partnerships
- connect networks thematically & discuss future networking based on thematic commonalities
- foster cooperation between all types of partnerships & help define useful activities among relevant stakeholders
- contribute to the rationalisation, restructuring and reform of partnerships towards Horizon Europe

Results:

- conclusions will be compiled in a report (end of May) & published online together with thematic analysis papers
- report will be provided to EC services, to networks, to national research funders, and to delegations in shadow configuration of strategic programme committee to support the future cooperation of partnerships

Non-goals:

the parallel sessions will **NOT** focus on

- **discussing the 44 suggested candidates of European Partnerships**
- **discussing the structured MS consultation on portfolio and 44 individual candidates**

why not:

- **Input to strategic coordinating process for European Partnerships is collected at national level in member states**
