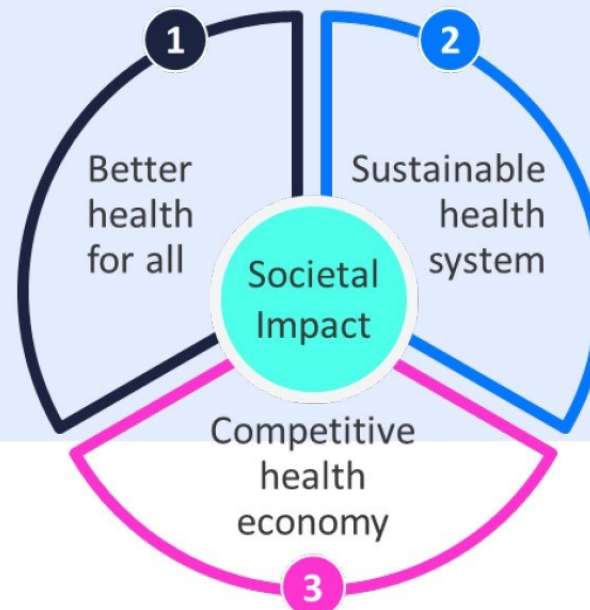
EIT Health is 1 of 8 Knowledge and Innovation Communities (KICs) of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), an EU body.

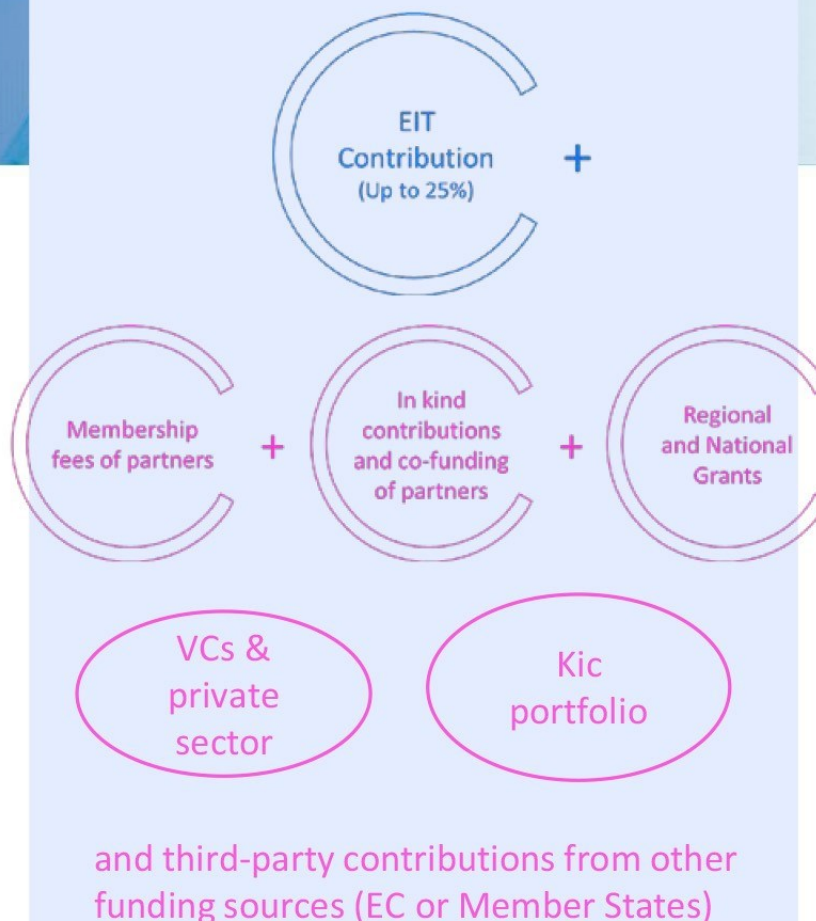

- Data protection and governance
- Interoperability

## POLICY AND FUNDING



### Main barriers

- Fragmentation of assessment approaches
- Regulatory rigidity
- Limited incentives for innovation

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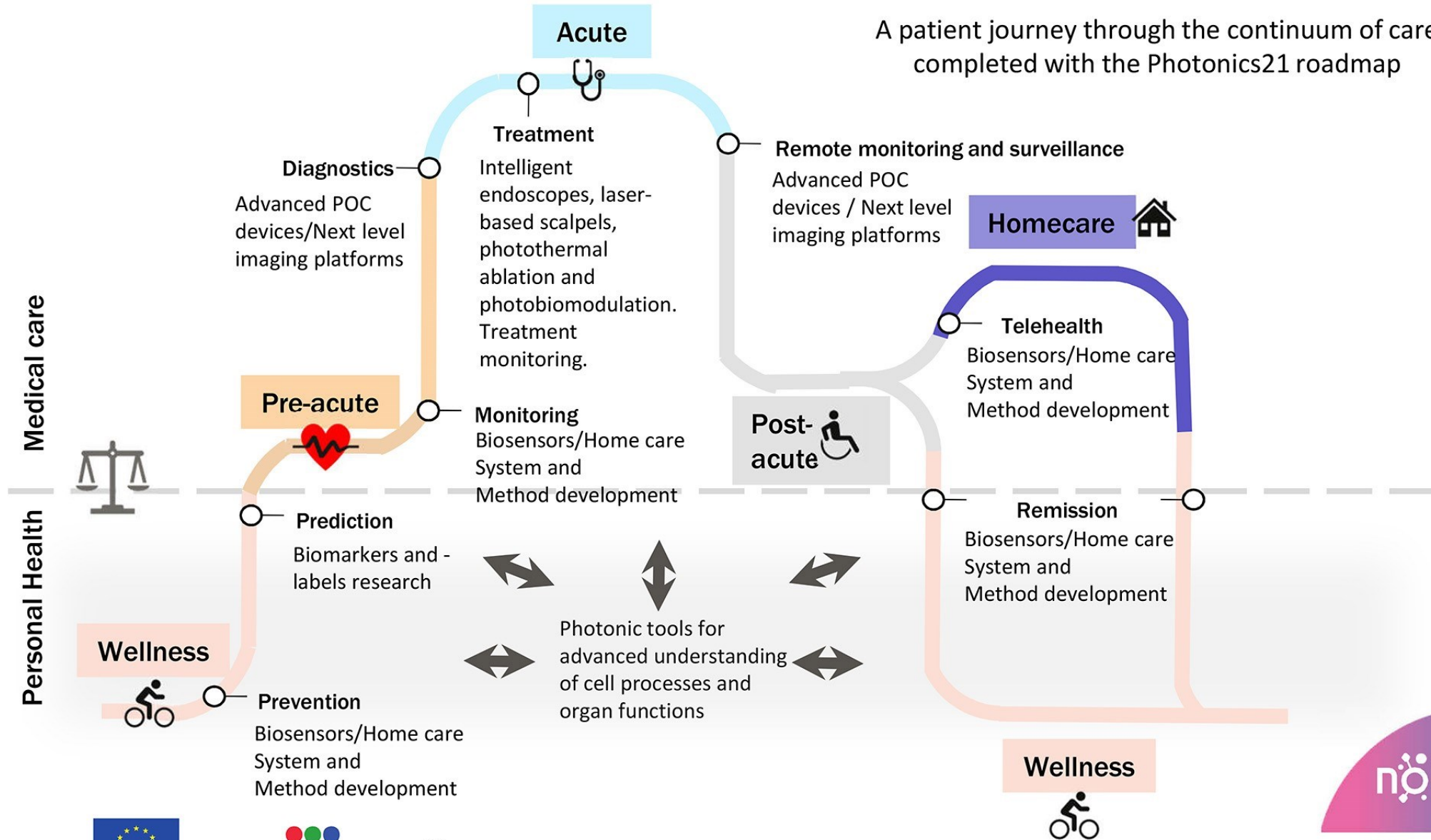
